

One Hundred Twenty-nine (129) and the South part East and West fractional Section Eleven (11), Township Fifteen (15) North, Range THREE (3) East and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Lot Two Hundred Fifty (250) in Simon Yandes' Subdivision of Out-lot One Hundred Twenty-nine (129) in the City of Indianapolis; thence West along the South line of said Lot Two Hundred Fifty (250) and along Ray Street in said City, to a point One Hundred Seventy-three and Seventy-five Hundredths (173.75) feet West of the Southeast corner of said Lot Two Hundred Fifty (250) and at the Southeast corner of a certain tract of land containing Eleven and Forty-five Hundredths (11.45) acres, more or less, described above; thence Northeastwardly and along the line of said Eleven and Forty-five Hundredths (11.45) acre tract, Three Hundred Thirty-eight and Sixty Hundredths (338.60) feet to a point on the West side of Lot Eighty (80) in Simon Yandes' Subdivision of Out-lot One Hundred Twenty-nine (129) at a point Eleven and Two Hundredths (11.2) feet Northeastwardly from the Southwest corner of said Lot Eighty (80); thence Southwestwardly along the West line of said Lot Eighty (80) to the Southwest corner of said Lot Eighty (80); thence Southwestwardly to the North-west corner of Lot eighty-three (83) in Simon Yandes' Subdivision of Lot One Hundred Twenty-nine (129); thence southwestwardly along the North line of Lots Eighty-one (81) Eighty-two (82), and Eighty-three (83) in said Subdivision to the Northwest corner of Lot Eighty-one (81) in said Subdivision; thence Southwestwardly in a direct line to the Northeast corner of Lot Two Hundred Fifty (250) in said Subdivision; thence South along the East line of said Lot Two Hundred Fifty (250) to the place of beginning.

46. POULTRY AND EGG RECEIVING STATION. All of the following described lot-piece-or-parcel-of land, situate in the City of North Manchester, County of Wabash, and State of Indiana, and known and described as follows, to wit:

The South Half of Lot Number Twenty-seven (27) in the Original Plat of the town of North Manchester, Indiana.

47. POULTRY PACKING STATION AND CREAMERY. All of the following described lot-piece-or-parcel-of land, situate in the City of Rochester, County of Fulton, and State of Indiana, and known and described as follows, to wit:

Commencing at a point where the North line of the Rochester and Warsaw wagon road crosses the East line of the Lake Erie and Western Railroad Company's right of way (formerly the Indianapolis and Michigan City Division of the Wabash, St. Louis and Pacific Railway Company), in section Thirty-one (31) Michigan Road Lands; thence North along the East line of said Railroad Company's lands Five Hundred and Thirty-four (534) feet and six (6) inches to the South line of the Chicago and Erie Railroad Company's right of way (formerly the Chicago and Atlantic Railway Company); thence Easterly along the line of said Chicago and Erie Railroad Company's lands Three Hundred and Twenty-five (325) feet and <sup>(4)</sup>Four/100 inches; thence Southerly at an angle of Ninety (90) degrees Twenty-five (25) minutes with the South line of the Chicago and Erie Railroad Company's right of way Four Hundred and nine (409) feet to the
