GENERAL WARRANTY DEED (CORPORATION)

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THIS INDENTURE, Made this 27th day of November A.D. 1923, between Berry-Hart Company, a corporation, organized under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, of Tulsa County, of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, party of the first part, and J.R. Ridgeway party of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred fifty (\$350.00) and no/100 .. Dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part does, by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of second part his heirs, executors or administrators, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to-wit;

Lot Twenty-seven (27) Block Four (4) Hunter Addition to the City of Tulsa, County of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the Duly recorded plat thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments, and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said Party of the First part, its successors or assigns, does hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, at the delivery of these presents that it is lawfully seized in its own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance in fee simple, of and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates judgments, taxes, assessments and encumbrances, of whatsoever nature and kind, Except, Taxes for years 1920, 1921, 1922 and 1923, and that said Corporation will WARRANT AND FOREVER DEFEND the same unto the said party of the second part, his heirs executors, and administrators, against said party of the first part, their successors or assigns, and all and every person or persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
