ANNEXATION HOLLYWOOD ADDITION.

O R D I N A N C E  
No. 2538.

An ordinance accepting and adding to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, a certain tract of land known as HOLLYWOOD ADDITION, to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, a petition in writing has been presented to the Mayor and Board of Commissioners, of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, signed by over sixty (60%) per cent of the property owners of the tract of land herein described and designated as Hollywood Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, said tract of land being in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and lying contiguous to and adjoining the present corporate limits of said City which petition prays that said Board annex to said City of Tulsa said tract of land, and

WHEREAS, it has been made to appear upon examination, by said Board that the tract of land herein described is platted into lots and blocks and is used for residential purposes, and it further appearing to said Board that the prayer of said petitioners should be granted and the land embraced in said petition should be annexed to said City and that all things necessary to be done for the proper annexation of said tract of land to said City have happened and have been performed, and that said action is for the benefit of all parties concerned.

NOW WHEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF TULSA, STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

Section 1. That a tract of land hereinafter described, the same being known as Hollywood Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and adjoining the present corporate limits of said City, being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

The NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  - the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  except the East 18 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet thereof - all of the W $\frac{1}{2}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  lying North of the M. K. & T. R. R., less a strip 18 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet wide off of the east side of said tract and also less a tract sold to the City of Tulsa for street purposes as follows:
