

Beginning at the intersection of the East line of Quannah Avenue and the North line of the M.K. & T Right of Way and running thence north along the East line of Quannah Avenue, 136.01 feet to the east projection of the north line of Brady Street, thence east 16.91 feet, thence southeasterly angle to right 55.46 feet, 118.08 feet to the north line of the M.K. & T Right of Way, thence Southwesterly along said right of way 69.2 feet to place of beginning-the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ less a tract 68 feet east and west by 165 North and South in the Southeast corner thereof, all of said land being located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, Twp. 19 North, Range 12 East, Tulsa County Oklahoma, containing 9.11 acres, more or less.

be and the same is hereby annexed to said City of Tulsa, To be known as Hollywood Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and the corporate limits of said City, be and the same are hereby extended to include the above described tract of land, provided, however, that the said tract is admitted to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma upon the condition and subject to the granting of perpetual easement by the owners of said tract of land to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, giving the City of Tulsa a perpetual right and easement to enter upon and use any portion of the above described tract of land and to build, construct, lay, maintain alter or repair any sewer lines, water lines, gas lines telephone lines, telegraph lines, electric lines or any other public utilities and the said right of perpetual easement covering all of said tract of land is hereby accepted by the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

Section 2. That from and after this ordinance takes effect the real estate described in Section 1 thereof, shall be a part of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and all persons residing therein and all property situated thereon, shall be and are hereby declared to be subject in all respects and particulars to the jurisdiction, control and laws and ordinances of said City of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

Section 3. That an emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety, by reason whereof this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.

PASSED and the emergency clause ruled upon separately, and approved this 7th. day of December, 1923.
