

MAINE.

60. BRANCH HOUSE. All of the following described lot, piece, or parcel, of land, situate in the City of Bangor, County of Penobscot, and State of Maine, and known and described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the corner of Front and Union Streets at the Easterly corner of Lot Number Thirteen (13) according to a plan of land owned by Abner Taylor and Charles Thomas, dated September 1, 1843, and recorded in the Registry of Deeds for said Penobscot County in Plan Book Number 2, Page 6; then Northwesterly on said Union Street Seventy-nine (79) feet Two and one-half ($2\frac{1}{2}$) inches to a point Three (3) inches Southeasterly of a granite monument on the dividing line between lots numbered Eleven (11) and Ten (10) according to said plan; thence Southwesterly and parallel with said dividing line One Hundred and Eleven (111) feet and Eight (8) inches to the Southwesterly line of the said Taylor & Thomas land in accordance with said plan; thence Southeasterly on said Southwesterly line forty (40) feet and Two and one-half ($2\frac{1}{2}$) inches to the Southeasterly line of Lot Number Twelve (12) according to said plan; thence Northeasterly on said Southeasterly line Fifteen (15) feet and Eleven and One-half ($11\frac{1}{2}$) inches Southwesterly from the place of beginning; thence Northeasterly on said Front Street to the place of beginning, together with all rights of way or other easements connected therewith or appertaining thereto, if any therebe.

61. BRANCH HOUSE. All of the following described lot, piece, or parcel, of land, situate in the City of Biddeford, County of York, and State of Maine, and known and described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at an iron bolt in the Southwesterly side line of Thornton Street at land now or formerly of Rishworth Jordan Fifty-three (53) feet Northwesterly from the Southwesterly side of ^{Elm and} Thornton Streets; thence by the Southwesterly side of Thornton Street North Forty-two (42) degrees, Forty-five (45) minutes West Fifty (50) feet to an iron bolt driven in the ground at land now or formerly of Deering Brothers; thence making a right angle with the last described line and running South Forty-seven (47) degrees Fifteen (15) minutes West Sixty (60) feet to an iron bolt driven in the ground at land of the Boston and Maine Railroad Company; thence South Forty-three (43) degrees, Thirty-four (34) minutes East by land of said Railroad Company Fifty and one one-hundredths (50.01) feet to land now or formerly of Rishworth Jordan; thence North Forty-seven (47) degrees, Fifteen (15) minutes East by land now or formerly of Rishworth Jordan Fifty-nine and Twenty-nine one-hundredths (59.29) feet to the point of beginning, containing Two thousand Nine hundred and Eighty-two and Twenty-five hundredths (2982.25) square feet, situate in the City of Biddeford, in said County and State; together with all the truckage rights of the grantors appurtenant to said property.

62. BRANCH HOUSE. All of the following described lot, piece, or parcel, of land, situate in the City of Baltimore, County of Baltimore, and State of Maryland, and known and described as follows, to wit:
