I hereby certify that the land described in the above deed was purchased for the said Joe Fulsom with funds HELD IN TRUST by the United States for his benefit derived from oil royalties from restricted land allotted to said Joe Fulsom by virtue of his enrollment as a full blood citizen of the Creek Nation, opposite No. 7279 on the final approved rolls of citizens by blood of that Nation, and that said purchase was made and said deed was executed, and the same is hereby approved pursuant to the regulations prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior under the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1908 and the Act of August 1, 1914.
