of the aforesaid lands with H.E.Bridges and have executed their Warranty Deed conveying the same, and present the same to be approved and validated by this Court. They represent that said lands are sold at the rate of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per Acre. That from the 120 acres composing the tract, there has been sold, condemned or disposed of for railway and public highway purposes, 9.3 acres, and that the total price of the remainder of the three forties is \$100.00 per acre, which said price is the highest price that has been offered for said lands, and is satisfactory to the Grantors herein, and which they agree and believe is the fair and just value of said lands at a cash purchase price at this time, particularly so, in consideration of the fact that said lands are now leased for agricultural purposes for the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) per annum per acre for a period of four (4) years.

Petitioners further represent that the land has no substantial value from an oil producing standpoint, same having been heretofore tested for oil without favorable results, and there being no demand for an oil lease thereon.

WHEREFORE, Your Petitioners pray that the Court hear the Petitioners relative to the above matter, and approve their deeds to the said H.E.Bridges.
