

City of Manchester, County of Hillsborough and State of New Hampshire, and known and described as follows, to wit:

A certain lot or parcel of land situated in said Manchester, bounded and described as follows, to wit: Beginning at a stake at the Northwest corner of the Premises in the southerly line of Granite Street, by land of the Concord Railroad and the Manchester and Lawrence Railroad; thence easterly by the southerly line of said Granite Street One Hundred and Ninety hundredths (100.90) feet to a hub set in the ground at land of Antionette L. Hill; thence southerly at right angles with said Granite Street by said Hill land One Hundred Twenty (120) feet to a Twenty-four (24) foot passage; thence westerly by said passageway and parallel with said Granite Street Fifty-seven and Forty-six hundredths (57.46) feet to a hub at land of the Concord Railroad and the Manchester and Lawrence Railroad; thence northerly at an angle of One Hundred Nine (109) degrees and Fifty-four (54) ^{773.1} fee minutes by land of said Railroad One Hundred Twenty-seven and Sixty-two hundredths (127.62) feet to the place of beginning; together with the right to use in connection with the strip of land hereinafter described (so as to make together a width of Twenty-four (24) feet for a passage-way as hereinafter mentioned) an additional strip of land of the width of Twelve (12) feet wide extending along on the western side of the westerly line of the premises above described from Granite Street southerly; saving, excepting and reserving the use of, in connection with the strip of land last above described for a passage-way, a strip of land Twelve (12) feet wide extending along the easterly side of the westerly line of said tract for the free passage of all persons owning or accepting land on either side of said passage-way, or those having business with them or either of them.

Also all those certain lots of land situate, lying and being in the City of Jersey City, in the County of Hudson and State of New Jersey, which are known as lots Six (6) to Twenty-Four (24) inclusive, in Block three hundred thirty (330) on the official assessment map of Jersey City of 1894.
