

## COMPARED

Also all those certain lots of land, situate, lying and being in the City of Jersey City, in the County of Hudson, State of New Jersey, and which are known as lots One (1) to Thirty-two (32) in Block Three hundred sixty-six (366), being the entire block as laid down and shown on an assessment map accompanying report No. 57, made by Commissioners of Adjustment appointed for Jersey City under the provisions of Chapter 3X11 of the laws of 1886, and supplements thereto and filed with their said report in the office of the Clerk of the County of Hudson.

Also all those certain lots, tracts or parcels of land in the County of Hudson and State of New Jersey, and premises situate, lying and being in Jersey City, more particularly bounded and described as follows:--

Beginning at a point in Block Three hundred Sixty-seven (367) where the Northerly line of 17th Street intersects with the Easterly line of Monmouth Street, running thence Easterly along the northerly line of 17th Street, Four hundred (400) feet to the Westerly line of Coles Street, thence Northerly along the Westerly line of Coles Street; Two hundred Thirty (230) feet to the center line of 18th Street, as it formerly existed; thence Westerly along the center line of 18th Street, as it formerly existed, Two hundred Fifty eight and Nine-tenths (258.9) feet, to a point; thence Southwesterly along a curve having a radius of Six hundred Thirty-six (636) feet, convex away from the land hereby described One hundred-three and Ninety-six hundredths (103.96) feet to a point in the center line of the old Harsimus Road; thence Northwesterly along the center of the old Harsimus Road Twenty eight and Seventy-four hundredths (28.74) feet to a point; thence Southwesterly along a curve having a radius of Six hundred and sixty-four (664) feet, convex away from the land hereby described, One hundred forty and Ninety-one one-hundredths (140.91) feet to a point in the Easterly line of Monmouth Street, distant Forty-six (46) feet Northerly from the Northerly line of 17th Street, and thence Southerly along the Easterly line of Monmouth Street, Forty-six (46) feet to the point or place of beginning.

87. BRANCH HOUSE. All of the following described lot, piece or parcel of land, situate in the City of Long Branch, County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, and known and described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin standing in the Southeast corner of the lot hereby conveyed in the line of the lands of the New York and Long Branch Railroad Company's and the North side of Morris Avenue; and running thence along the North side of Morris Avenue South Eighty-four (84) degrees and Five (5) minutes West One Hundred and Fifty-four (154) feet to a stake in the East side of Third Avenue as now laid out; thence along said Avenue North Seven (7) degrees and Five (5) minutes East Fifty (50) feet; thence North Eighty-four (84) degrees and Five (5) minutes East One Hundred and Fifty-four (154) feet to the West line of lands belonging to the New York and Long Branch Railroad Company; thence South Seven (7) degrees and Forty (40) minutes West along said Company's line Fifty (50) feet to the place of beginning, situate in the village of Long Branch in said County and State, together
