Tract No. 3. Being a part of lots Nos. 343 and 344 in the City of Canton, Stark County, Ohio, as numbered upon the corrected schedule of lots in said City, which lies Northwest of the Pittsburgh, Fort Wayne and Chicago Railroad, excepting therefrom ten (10) feet off of the West side of lot No. 343 and a strip of four (4) feet in width heretofore conveyed to the Pittsburgh, Fort Wayne and Chicago Railroad Company off of Lots Nos. 343 and 344, as recorded in Deed Records, Vol. 413, Page 552, and further described as follows: Beginning at a point on the South line of Tuscarawas Street East ten (10) feet East of the Northwest corner of Lot No. 343; thence East with the South line of said Tuscarawas Street East, eighty-six and two-tenths (86.2) feet, to a point, said point being thirty-three and eighty-three hundredths (33.83) feet measured at right angles from the center line of the East bound main track of said Pittsburgh, Fort Wayne and Chicago Railroad; thence in a southwesterly direction and parallel to said center line one hundred and twenty-one and five hundredths (121.05) feet to a point; thence North and parallel to the West line of Lot No. 343, eighty-four and eight-tenths (84.8) feet to the place of beginning.

Together with all the trackage rights of the grantors appurtenant to said property.

95. BRANCH HOUSE. All of the following described lot, piece, or parcel of land, situate in the City of Columbus, County of Franklin, and State of Ohio and known and described as follows, to wit:

All that part of Lots numbers Fifteen Hundred Twenty-three (1523) Fifteen Hundred Twenty-four (1524) and Fifteen Hundred Twenty-five (1525), as said lots are numbered and distinguished on the recorded plat of Hailes and Shankles Addition to the City of East Liverpool, being part of Section Twenty-three (23) Township Five (5) North, Range One (1) which lies Southwestwardly of the present right of way of the Hill Track of the Cleveland and Pittsburgh Railroad and bounded as follows, to wit:
