Southwesterly line of the present right of way of the "Hill Track," of the Cleveland and Pittsburgh Railroad Company, One Hundred Twenty and Thirteen hundredths (120.13) feet; thence Westwardly along the Southerly line of East 7th Street (formerly Hailes Street), Thirty-six and Seventy-three hundredths (36.73) feet, to the place of beginning; together with all the trackage rights of the grantors appurtenant to said property.
