(13 ) fifty-eight minutes (58') fifty seconds (50") West, Twenty and seventy-seven hundredths (20.77) feet; thence along property of J. Ogden Armour, parallel with Lacock Street, North Seventy-six degrees (76 ) , forty-six minutes (46') fifty seconds (50") East, one hundred thirty-nine and forty-six hundredths (139.46) feet; thence along the Westerly line of Scoville Street, South fourteen degrees (14 ) eighteen minutes (18') ten seconds (10") East, Twenty and seventy-seven hundredths (20.77) feet to the place of beginning.

Also, Beginning on the northwest corner of Lacock Street, fifty feet wide, and Scoville Street (formerly Scott Street, also formerly Gray's Alley), twenty feet wide; running thence along the northerly line of Lacock Street, South seventy six degrees (76 ) forty six minutes (46') fifty seconds (50") West, one hundred forty and five hundredths (140.05) feet to the easterly line of Anderson Street; thence along said easterly line of Anderson Street, sixty feet wide, North thirteen degrees (13 ) fifty eight minutes (58') fifty seconds (50") West, Forty-two and seventy-seven hundredths (42.77) feet; thence parallel with Lacock Street North seventy six degrees (76 ) forty six minutes (46') fifty seconds (50") East, one hundred thirty-nine and eighty-one hundredths (139.81) feet along property of Elizabeth Y. Stephenson, and heretofore conveyed to A. Watson Armour, to the westerly line of Scoville Street, thence South fourteen degrees (14 ) eighteen minutes (18') ten seconds (10") East, Forty-two and seventy-seven hundredths (42.77) feet along said westerly line of Scoville Street to the place of beginning.
