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January, 1917, which said agreement, however, was never presented to the Secretary of the Interior for approval although said right-of-way has ever since the execution of the said instrument been definitely fixed.

NOW THEREFORE in consideration of the original conveyance made by said Maggie Smith nee Loler to Ed. T. Egan through whom second party derails title to the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section, the said first parties do hereby set aside, designate, grant, bargain and convey unto the said second party its successors and assigns a way of necessity in, on and over the remaining lands of the said deceased allottee situate in said Section above described for ingress and egress to and from the lands of said second party, to and from the section line of said section as long as the necessity therefore shall exist and no longer, a strip of land one rod wide along the west side of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said section twenty-six (26) Township eighteen (18) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, and

IT IS FURTHER agreed between the parties hereto that the said second party is to keep a fence on the west side of the lane thus formed in repair, and to build a fence on the East side of said lane such fence to be kept in repair jointly by the parties hereto.
