RELEASE OF MORTGAGE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, The Exchange National Bank, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, a corporation, in consideration of the value received, do hereby acknowledge full payment and complete satisfaction of a certain mortgage given by W. Nineteen (19) North, Range Twelve (12) East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma.
