132. BRANCH HOUSE. All that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate in the City of Madison, County of Dane and State of Wisconsin, known and described as follows, to wit:

The Northeast Four (4) feet in width of the northwest one hundred fifty (150) feet in length of lot numbered Five (5), and the southwest Sixty-two (62) feet in width of the Northwest One Hundred Fifty (150) feet in length of lot numbered Six (6), of Block One hundred Twenty-two (122) in the city of Madison, Dane County, Wisconsin, according to the recorded plat thereof, together with the right to use of spurtrack running from the Chicago and Northwestern Railway Company yards across said block One Hundred Twenty-two (122) and Block One Hundred Twenty-three (123); but it is expressly understood that such use shall be a joint use with the State of Wisconsin and others; the said spur track having been extended over and upon said blocks by virtue of license given by Holden Snell to said Railway Company recorded March 13, 1899, at 10.45 O'clock A.M. in Volume 9 of Miscellaneous Records on Page 375 in the office of the Register of Deeds, in and for Dane County, aforesaid, together with all trackage rights and privileges appurtenant to said premises.

133. MILK RECEIVING STATION. All that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate in the City of Milton Junction, County of Rock and State of Wisconsin, known and described as follows, to wit:

All that certain part or parcel of land, situate, lying, and being in the Village of Milton Junction, County of Rock, and State of Wisconsin, known and distinguished as a lot in the N.E. Quarter of Section Twenty-eight (28), Township Four (4), North, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Fourth Principal Meridian, more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a point in the center of the Highway leading from Chicago to Madison, at its junction with the Westerly line of the right-of-way of the Chicago and Northwestern Railway; thence North Seventy-six (76) degrees, Thirty (30) minutes West Forty-nine and one-half ( $49\frac{1}{2}$ ) feet; thence North Seven (7) degrees, Thirty (30) minutes West Four Hundred Eighty-seven and Seventy-four Hundredths (487.74) feet; thence North eighty-five (85) degrees East, one hundred sixty and two-tenths (160.2) feet; thence Northerly, Three Hundred and Six (306) feet; thence Easterly, One Hundred and Fifty (150) feet to a point on the said Westerly line of the Chicago and Northwestern Railway right-of-way; thence Southerly along said Westerly line Eight Hundred Fifty-eight and Forty-two Hundredths ( $858\frac{42}{100}$ ) feet to the point of beginning.
