KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the undersigned, Middleton J. Hickey and Nellie F. Hickey, his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollars (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby sell, convey, assign, and set over to Harry Campbell of the firm of Biddison & Campbell, Lawyers, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, all their right, title and interest in and to an option contract dated February 15, 1923, given by Ed. Baker to Middleton J. Hickey, granting to said Middleton J. Hickey the right to purchase the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-five (25), Township Seventeen (17) North, Range Thirteen (13) East in Tulsa, County, State of Oklahoma, at any time within one year from said 15th day of February, 1923, for the sum of Sixteen Thousand Six Hundred twenty-five Dollars and Forty Cents (\$16625.40), according to the terms and provisions of said contract, which said option contract was recorded in the Office of the County Clerk of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, on the 23 day of February, 1923 in Record Book 432, page 456
