

R. L. WILLIAMS, Judge of said Court:

Whereas, it appears from the report of the Hon. A. F. McGarr, to whom, as special master the bankrupt's application for discharge was heretofore referred under Rule III of this Court, that William Reedman, who has been duly adjudged a bankrupt under the Acts of Congress relating to Bankruptcy, and has conformed to all the requirements of law in that behalf, therefore;

It Is Ordered, Adjudged and Decreed, by the Court that the report of said master is hereby, in all things approved, and confirmed and that said bankrupt be discharged from all debts and claims which are made provable by said Acts against his estate and which existed on the 6 day of July, 1921, on which day the petition in bankruptcy was filed against him, excepting such debts as are by law excepted from the operation of a discharge in bankruptcy.

It is further Ordered, Adjudged and Decreed by the Court that the expenses of this proceeding, reported by the special master in the sum of \$15.75, be and the same are hereby taxed and allowed as cost against the bankrupt's estate.
