ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS LEASE.

WHEREAS, The Secretary of the Interior has heretofore approved an oil and gas mining lease, dated May 2nd 1921, entered into by and between Waite Phillips and Fred A. Stubbs, lessees and Ben Scraper, lessor, covering the following described lands in the Cherokee Nation, Oklahoma:

W $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32 and the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, Township 22 N
Range 13E.

Whereas Fred A. Stubbs now owns an undivided three-eighths interest in said lease.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) dollar, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said Fred A. Stubbs, the lessee in the above-described lease, hereby bargains, sells, transfers, assigns, and conveys all the undivided 3/8ths interest in the right, title, and interest of the lessee in and to said lease, subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Interior, to Waite Phillips Company of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

Said assignment to be effective from date of approval hereof by the Secretary of the Interior.
