HAVE GRANTED, SOLD AND CONVEYED and by these presents do GRANT, SELL AND CONVEY unto the said Woodson E. Norvell of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land lying and being situated in Tuksa County, Oklahoma, and being Lot #72 in Graceland Section, containing 820.5 square feet, be the same more or less out of ROSE HLLL BURIAL PARK as more fully appears from map of said Burial Park hereby referred to and made a part hereof.
