

## TRUSTEE'S DEED

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 1st day of February A.D. 1923, between the TITLE GUARANTEE & TRUST COMPANY, a Corporation, as Trustee, organized under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, having its principal place of business in Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, party of the first part, and Callie Totten party of the second part,

WITNESSETH, That in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other valuable considerations, Dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, said party of the first part does by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part, his heirs, executors, or administrators, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to-wit: all of Lot Seven (7) Block Three (3) Ridgedale Terrace Second Addition to the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

Said Trustee, on behalf of those owning beneficial interest in said real estate at the time of the execution of this deed as is shown in a certain Warranty Deed now of record in the Office of the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in Book 395 at Page 359, but not on behalf of itself, covenants and agrees with the party of the second part that the party of the first part at the time of the delivery of these presents is seized of a good and indefeasible title and state of inheritance in in fee simple in and to said real estate, and covenants that it is in peaceful and undisputed possession of said premises with full right and power to convey the same by this instrument to said party of the second part, and that the same is clear, free, and discharged of and from all former and other grants, charges, taxes, judgments, and other liens or encumbrances of whatsoever kind or nature, and hereby binds those having the beneficial interest in said premises, their heirs and assigns forever to observe the covenants and agreements herein contained, and to warrant and defend the Title to said land against all claims of every nature. Improvements to be erected on said lot are restricted to one residence and garage, costing not less than Twenty-Five Hundred Dollars (2500.00), and that said lot shall be not sold to persons of African descent.
