THIS INDENTURE, Made this 28th day of November 1922, between Charles M. Fenoughty, and Anna M. Fenoughty, his wife of Miami County, in the State of Kansas of the first part, and Emma F. Sheehy, of Miami County, in the State of Kansas of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.000) Dollar and other considerations the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, REMISE, Release and QUIT-CLAIM, unto said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns, all the following described REAL ESTATE, situated in the County of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

A strip of land twenty five feet wide extending across the south end of lots one (1) and two (2) in block thirty five (35) in Sand Springs, Oklahoma, as per the recorded plat thereof and subject to the restrictions that are in the original deed from Charles Page to Daniel A. Dabney, and Alice A. Dabney, his wife, and recorded in Book 106 page 617 of the Tulsa county records, for Tulsa County, and State of Oklahoma,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever:
