other improvements upon said premises in as good repair and condition as the same are in at this date, and abstain from the commission of waste on said premises until the note hereby secured is fully paid.

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FIFTH. Said parties of the first part hereby agree that if the makers of said notes shall fail to pay or cause to be paid any part of said money, either principal or interest, according to the tenor and effect of said note and coupons, when the same becomes due, or to conform or camply with any of the foregoing conditions, or agreements, the whole sum of money hereby secured shall, at the option of the legal holder or holders hereof, become due and payable at once without notice.

AND the said parties of the first part, for said consideration, do hereby expressly waive or not, at option of mortgagee an appraisement of said real estate, and all benenfits of the homestead exemption and stay laws of the state of Oklahoma.

The foregoing conditions being performed, this covenant to be void; otherwise of full force and virtue.

SIXTH. In case of default of payment of any sum herein convenanted to be paid, for the period of thirty days after the same becomes due, or in default of performance of any covenant herein contained, the said first parties agree to pay to said second party and his acsigns, interest at the rate of ten per cent per annum, corputed annually on said principal note, from the date thereof to the time when the money shall be actually paid. Any payments made on account of interest shall be credited in said computation so that the total amount of interest collected shall be, and not exceed, the legal rate of 10 per cent per arnum.

SEVENTE. It is further agreed that on the filing of any petition to foreclose this mortgage the first parties shall paya reasonable attorney's fee of not less than Four Hundred Fifty Dollars, and the same to be secured by this mortgage and to be taxed as a part of the costs in said action.
