electric lines or any other public utilities and the said right of perpetual easement covering all of said tract of land is hereby accepted by the City of Tulsa. Oklahoma.

SECTION 2. That from and after this ordinance takes effect and the real estate described in Section 1, hereof, shall be a part of the City of Tulsa. Oklahoma, and all persons residing therein and all property situated thereon, shall be and are hereby declared to be subject in all respects and particulars to the jurisdiction, control and laws and ordinances of said City of Tulsa. Oklahoma/

SECTION 3. That an emergency exists for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, by reason whereof, this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.

PASSED, and the emergency clause ruled upon separately, and approved this 2nd day of Marc, 1923.
