Yocum of ----, the first party, in consideration of the sum of Valuable considerations and one Dollar the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, by these presents, remises, releases, and forever quitclaim unto Perry M Childers, the present owner of hereinafter described lot the second party, and heirs and assigns, all the right title, interest, estate, claim and demand, of first part, both at law and in equity, in and to all the following described real property situated in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma to-wit: Lot Ten (10) Block Five (5) in Clinton Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, Tulsa County according to the recorded plat thereof.

(This deed is given to correct an error made in a deed dated Dec 4th 1922 by and between Thos R Shaw and Lewis C Yocum, said deed being recorded in Book 429 page 350 of the Tulsa County records, Tulsa, Okla.) together with all and cingular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the premises above described unto the said second party and heirs and assigns so that neither the said first party nor any person in the name and behalf of such party shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right or title to the said premises or any part thereof; but they and every one of them, shall by these presents be excluded and forever barred.
