The affiant, C. N. Wickizer, says that he is sixty two years of age, that he is the C. N. Wickizer who is named as trustee in a deed executed on the 7th day of November, 1911, by Charles W. Grimes, Trustee, to C. N. Wickizer, Trustee by which said Charles W. Grimes, Trustee, sold and conveyed to the said C. N. Wickizer, Trustee, lot No. five (5) in Block No. 7, Midway addition to the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof, said deed is of record in the office of the county clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, record 100, page 265. The affiant states that he was named as trustee in said deed for the Christian Endeavor Society of the First Christian Church of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma; that this society was not incorporated, but was merely a body of young people who were members of the First Christian Church and who were engaged in doing christian work; that they purchased said lot and deeded it to him as trustee to be held by him and to be conveyed for the use and benefit of said Church; that said Christian Endeavor Society as it existed at the time said deed was made is no longer in existence, and that this lot was to be used, as stated for the advancement and purposes of the First Christian Church, and to be conveyed by this trustee for the use and benefit of said church, and as said church might direct. The affiant states that he hasn't a penny of interest in said lot so far as he is individually concerned, and that he has never at any time received a penny in any way from the sale of said lot; that all that he has done is to hold the title for the purposes indicated above, and that he was conveyed same at the request and direction of the First Christian Church directly to the church itself.
