

XVII.

The Trustees shall provide a seal for the trust and inscribed thereon shall be the following words and figures "Seal, 1923".

XXIII

All certificates of beneficial interest shall be signed by the President, shall be attested by such officer of the trust as the trustees may decide upon, and shall bear the seal of the trust. No assessment shall ever be made upon the holders of certificates of beneficial interest.

XXIV.

All instruments requiring the signatures of the trustees shall be signed by the President and Treasurer and attested by the Secretary., and when as signed, shall be binding as if signed by all of the trustees.

XXV.

If for any reason the said Declaration of Trust is legally declared void, then this Amended Declaration of Trust shall be considered and treated as an original declaration of trust.
