Finlayson, which mortgage is recorded in book 331, page 414 in the Register's of Deeds office in Tulsa County, Oklahoma; said mortgage was given to secure the payment of a certain promissory note for the sum of \$4000.00 payable February 24, 1923, such note now payable to the order of Annie Taylor Jones, Trustee and Executrix of the estate of James K.
