H. Messimer, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey, release and forever quit claim unto the said C. H. Messimer, all right, title and interest I have had, have, or might in the future have had, arising from an instrument dated Tampico, Mexico, September 6, 1915, wherein it appears that said C. H. Messimer holds in trust for me a 1/2 interest of a 1/8 interest in all profits arising from a subsoil lease on lands described as follows: located in the Republic of Mexico, State of Veracruz, said lands known as Spellacy-Topila tract, comprising 8 hectares 2100 square meters, the lease now owned by The Texas Company of Mexico, S.A. to have and to hold unto said C. H. Messimer his heirs and assigns forever binding myself, my heirs and assigns forever, to warrant and defend said interest and to hold said C. H.
