EASEMENT AGREEMENT FOR PUBLIC HIGHWAY RIGHT OF WAY.

This agreement, made and entered into this the 21st day of February, 1923, by and between Anna Fabela, party of the first part, and the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, by its chairman, party of the second part.

Witnesseth: That the party of the first part is the owner in fee simple of the south one half ( $S\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the southeast quarter ( $SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section one (1) township nineteen (19) north, range ten (10) east in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and that the second party is constructing a public highway thru and across said land which requires additional right of way to properly construct said highway, therefore the said <sup>first</sup> party for a consideration of one (1.00) dollar, and other considerations hereafter named hereby agrees that the second party may enter upon said land at a point near the center of the east line of said land where the present public highway enters said land, and reconstruct and maintain said highway, the right of way of which is fifty four (54) feet wide and beginning on a curve to the right the radius of which is two hundred (200') feet. to a point of intersection with the present highway, thence in a south-westerly direction along the present highway to its intersection with the west line of said land.

As a further consideration for the above described easment the said second party hereby agrees to rebuild all fences on the proper line, said fences to be rebuilt in as good condition as now exists; also to reconstruct a certain drainage ditch which begins at the center on the south line of the M.K. & T. R'y right of way, and running south to a point where it crosses the highway.
