For and in consideration of the sum of ten and no/100 (\$10.00) dol lars to them in hand paid by F. Weidner, Supt. The receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Kayah Lucas and John Lucas, her husband of Christie, Oklahoma, do hereby grant to The Tulsa Fuel & Manufacturing Company, its successors or grantess, the right of way to lay, maintain, operate, relay and remove a pipe line for the transportation of gas, with the right of ingress and egress thereto, said right of waybeing more fully described by definite plat of location attached, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, and on, over and through the following described land:
