This indenture made the - - - day of February, 1923, at Tulsa, Oklahoma, by and between Alice Cole, the duly appointed qualified and acting guardian of Burl David Cole, party of the first part and 4. M. Price, the party of the second part,

Witnesseth, that whereas, on the 23rd day of March, 1920, the county court within and for the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, made an order of sale, authorizing the said party of the first part, to sell certain real estate of the said Burl David Cole, situated in the County of Pulsa, State of Oklahoma, described in said order of sale.

And whereas, under and by virtue of said order of sale, and pursuant to legal notices given thereof, the said party of the first part, on the 12th day of April, A. D. nineteen hundred and twenty, sold the hereinafter described real estate specified and described in said order of sale, subject to confirmation by said Court, for the sum of six hundred sixty six and 66-2/3/100 (\$666.66 2/3) dollars to H.
