

\$1,597.25, with interest at 8% from the date of said judgement, to-wit: 23rd day of August, 1922, and the further sum of \$170.00 as attorney's fees.

And judgement in favor of S. E. Skiver and Ocie A. Skiver, on the 23rd day of August, 1922, in the sum of \$1,121.88, bearing interest at 8% per annum from said date, in addition thereto \$110.00 as attorney's fees.

And judgement in favor of W. H. Botkin, on the said 23rd day of August, 1922, in the sum of \$592.60, which said judgement bears interest at 10% ^{said} from date, and the further sum of \$159.26, as attorney's fee.

And judgement in favor of Rounds & Porter Lumber Company, a corporation, on the said 23rd day of August, 1922, in the sum of \$203.00 which judgement bears interest at 6% per annum from said date, and the further sum of \$50.00 attorney's fee.

And judgement in favor of Kilmer Paint & Glass Company, a corporation, on the 23rd day of August, 1922, in the sum of \$53.50, with interest at 6% per annum from January 21, 1921, and the further sum of \$50.00 attorney's fees.

And judgement in favor of Harold T. Wright in the sum of \$48.50 with interest at 6% from the 21st day of January, 1921, together with attorney's fees in the sum of \$50.00.

Whereon, on the 23rd day of February, 1923, pursuant to said notice of sale, the Sheriff did offer said property for sale at public auction at the west front door of the Court house of the city of Tulsa, in said County of Tulsa, at the hour of 2:00 o'clock P.M., at which sale the said property was sold and struck off to the said S. E. Skiver, the party of the second part, for \$4,700.00, the said S. E. Skiver being the highest bidder, and the same being the highest sum bidden, and the whole price paid the same being
