ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS LEASE.

Whereas, the Secretary of the Interior has heretofore approved an oil and gas mining lease, dated the 19th day of July, 1911, entered into by and between Mary Tecumseh, a minor, by Austin Tecumseh, her guardian, lessor, and Dubuque Oil & Gas Company, of Pittsburgh, Pa., and Bartlesville, Okla./ lessee, covering the following described lands in the Creek Nation, Oklahoma:

The northeast quarter (NE/4) of section 34,
township 17 north, range 14 east, Tulsa County,
Oklahoma, containing 160 acres, more or less.

Now, therefore, for and in consideration of one and no/100 (\$1.00) dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, assignee of the lessee in the above described lease, hereby bargains, sell, transfers, assigns, and conveys all right, title, and interest of the lessee in and to said lease in so far as it pertains to an undivided one-half interest in and to all the oil rights and privileges in and to said lease, subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Interior to Oklahoma Eastern Oil Company, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, Said assignment to be effective from date of approval hereof by the Secretary of the Interior.
