AFFIDAVIT.

that he is a resident of the State of Oklahoma, and is of legal age.

The affiant further states that on the 11th day of March, 1922,
Grace A. Dowell conveyed by warranty deed to himself, the following described land;

Lot nineteen (19) in Block four (4) Reddin
addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma,
according to the recorded plat thereof,

and that in the body of this deed an exception was made in a second mortgage in the
amount of seven hundred twenty five dollars (\$725.00).

his wife, conveyed the above described land by warranty deed to Nellie E. Williams in
which an exception was made of the second mortgage due in the amount of seven hundred
seventy five dollars (\$775.00).
