OIL AND GAS MINING LEASE.

COMPARED

Know all men by these presents: That whereas, on the 26th day of February,
 1923, Albert Oskison as guardian of Gilbert Felling, a minor, filed in this court
 his verified petition, praying leave and authority of this court to lease/certain
 said minor, in said petition described. for oil and gas mining purposes, and,

Whereas, the court upon the filing of said petition, set the same down for
 hearing and directed notice to be given thereon as provided by law, and thereafter
 on the 26th day of March, 1923, the said matter came on for hearing before the court
 and all persons interested having notice thereof, testimony was taken, heard and
 considered, and the court decreed the sale of an oil and gas mining lease on, over and
 upon the lands of the minor as hereinafter described, and directed the sale thereof to
 be advertised in Tulsa County, Oklahoma,

And, whereas, on the 14th day of April, 1923, the matter of the sale came on
 and was had at the chambers of the County Judge in the Court House in Vinita, Craig
 County, Oklahoma, and the lease sold to the highest bidder, and F. A. Stubbs being the
 highest and best bidder therefor, the guardian sold the said land to him, and thereafter
 made and returned to and filed in the court the guardian's return and account of sales
 and prayed the approval thereof by this court.

And upon the hearing on the return and account of said sales the court made
 and entered an order in words and figures as follows:

"It is therefore considered, adjudged and decreed, by the court that the sale
 of the oil and gas lease, covering the following described lands, to-wit:

The north half of the southeast quarter of the northeast
 quarter (N $\frac{1}{2}$ -SE $\frac{1}{4}$ -NE $\frac{1}{4}$) and southwest quarter of the south-
 east quarter of the northeast quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of section
 twenty eight (28) in township twenty two (22) north and range
 thirteen (13) East, in Tulsa County, Oklahoma

which said sale was made by Albert Oskison, as guardian on April 14th, 1923, selling
 and oil and gas lease on and over and upon the above described lands for a term and
 period of one year, and as long thereafter as oil and gas or either of them are found
 thereon and produced in paying quantities, for and in consideration of the receipt of
 \$2.50 per acre bonus, and one eighth (1/8) of all oil and gas produced and saved from
