AFFIDAVIT.

Martin, being first duly sworn on oath, states that he is a resident of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and has been for many years past, that he was one of the organizers of the Red Star Oil Company, a corporation, and that said corporation heretofore, during its corporate existence, purchased from B. T. Hainer an oil and gas mining lease bearing date of July 19, 1913, given by W. R. Chastain, as lessor, to the said B. T. Hainer, as lessee, covering the following described land located in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

The northeast quarter of the southeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$),

Affiant states that he was the attorney for said company, and also was a creditor thereof, and knows that said company asserted no interest in said lands on account of said lease or otherwise after it abandoned same as aforesaid.
