Said Trustee, on behalf of those own ing the beneficial interest in saud real estate at the time of the execution of this deed, as is shown in a certain Trust Agreement now of record in the office of the County Clerk, Ex-Officio Register of Deeds, of said County and State, dated the 15th day of November, 1919, but not on behalf of itself, covenants and agrees with the party of the second part that the party of the first part at the time of delivery of these presents is seized of a good and indefersible title and estate of inheritance in fee simple in and to said wall estate and covemants that it is in peaceful and undisputed possession of said premises, with full power to convey the same by this instrument to said party of the second part, and that the same is clear, free and discharged of and from all former and other grants, charges, taxes, judgements and other liens of incumbrances of whatsoever kind or nature, and hereby binds those having the beneficial interest in said premises, their heirs and assigns, forever, to observe the covenants and agreements herein contained and to warrant and defend the title to said lend, against all claims of every nature.
