

**COMPARED**

Whereas, a certain written agreement was entered into heretofore on the \_\_\_\_ day of June, 1917, by and between H. C. Rennie, party of the first part, E. J. McJunkin, party of the second part, and C. R. Thurlwell, and S. A. Boorstin, parties of the third part, under the conditions of which said E. J. McJunkin, C. R. Thurlwell, and S. A. Boorstin were to receive certain interests in the oil and gas rights in and to the following described lands to wit:

The southwestquarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the southeast (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) quarter of the northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the north half of the northeastquarter (N $\frac{1}{2}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section twenty four (24) township nineteen (19) north, range twelve (12) east, Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

which agreement was filed for record in the office of the County Clerk in and for Tulsa County, Oklahoma, on the 31st day of January, 1920, and recorded in book 288 at page 552 of the records thereof, and,

Whereas, said second party and third parties desire to release unto said first party any and all rights that they may have acquired by virtue of said agreement.

Now, therefore, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable considerations to them in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said E. J. McJunkin, C. R. Thurlwell, and S. A. Boorstin, hereby release, remise, relinquish, and forever quit claim all their right, title or interest in or to the lands above described, which they may have acquired by virtue of said agreement, to the said H. C. Rennie, his heirs and assigns forever.
