AGREEMENT, Made and entered into the 16th, day of March, 1922, by and between Russell I. Bilby and Nicholas V. Bilby, Commonly known as N. V. Bilby and R. I. Bilby, Party of the first part, hereinafter called lessor (whether one or more) and W. H. Allen, party of the second part, hereinafter called lessee.

WITNESSETH, That the said lessor for and in consideration of One and no/100, DOLLARS, cash in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and of the covenants and agreements hereinafter contained on the part of lessee to be paid, kept and performed, have granted, demised, leased and let and by these presents do grant, demise, lease and let unto the said lessee, for the sole and only purpose of mining and operating for oil and gas, and of laying pipe lines, and of building tanks, powers, stations and structures thereon to produce, save and take care of said products, all that certain tract of land situate in the Count of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, described as follows, to-wit:
