Whereas, thereafter, to-wit, on the 18th, day of May 1920, the aforesaid W. O. Dickenson and Stella M. Dickenson, his wife, executed and delivered to Tulsa County, Oklahoma, a quit claim deed to the aforesaid land described in the aforesaid two deeds. Said deed was filed for record in the office of the county clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, on the 18th, day of May, 1920, and is recorded in Book 348, page 138; and,

Whereas, the grantee in the last named deed should have been J. P. McLane, as said J. P. McLane was on the 18th, day of May, 1920, the owner of said land under and by virtue of the conveyance made by Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to him on the 10th, day of April, 1920.

Now, the premises considered, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, that Tulsa County execute and deliver to the said J. P. McLane, his heirs and assigns, a wuit claim deed to the aforesaid tract of land, which contains 4.449 acres, more or less, said 4.449 acres being the property of the said J. P. McLane and Tulsa County having no right, title or interest therein since the above mentioned conveyance of April 10, 1920, this deed being executed to clear the said J. P. McLane's title to said 4.449 acres, if a deed be necessary to clear it, said J. P. McLane having requested that such deed be executed. It is so ordered, all the commissioners voting for the resolution.

The foregoing resolution was regularly passed at a meeting regularly called by the County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma held on the 5th, day of March, 1923.
