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AND IT IS FURTHER AGREED that upon a breach of the war anty herein or upon a fail ure to pay when due any sum, interest or principal secured hereby, or any tax or asses sment herein mentioned or to comply with any requirements herein or upon any waste upon said premises, or any removal or destruction of any building or other improvements thereon, without the consent of the said second party, the whole sum secured hereby shall at once and without notice become due and payable at the option of the holder thereof and shall bear interest thereafter at the rate of 10 per cent per annum, and the said party of the second part or its assigns shall be entitled to a foreclosure of this mortgage and to have the said premises sold and the proceeds amplied to the payment of the sums secured hereby; and that immediately upon the filing of the peitions in foreclosure the holder hereof shall be entitled to the possession of the said premises, and to collect and apply the rents thereof, less reasonable expenditures, to the payment of said indebtedness, and for this purpose the holder thereof shall be entitled to a receiver, to the appointment of which the mortgagors hereby consent, which appointment may be made wither before or after the decree of foreclosure, and the holder hereof shall in no case be held to account for any rental or damage other than for rents actually received; and the appraisement of said premises is hereby expressly And all the covenants and agreements herein contained shall run with the land herein conveyed.
