

RIGHT OF WAY AGREEMENT

FOR and in consideration of the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars to him in hand paid by F. Weidner, Supt., THE RECEIPT OF WHICH IS HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGED, Ewing Halsell does hereby grant to The Tulsa Fuel & Manufacturing Company, its successors or grantees, the right of way to lay, operate, maintain, relay and remove all pipe lines for the transportation of gas, with-in the right of ingress and egress thereto, said right of way being more fully described by definite plat of location attached, situated in the County of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma, and on, over and through the following described land:

$N\frac{1}{2}$  of  $SE\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 15, Township 21 North, Range 13,  
East of the Indian Base and Meridian, containing 80  
acres, more or less

The said grantor, his heirs or grantees, and the public are to fully use and enjoy the said premises, except the easement hereinbefore granted. This easement is for a period of fifteen years from date.

The said The Tulsa Fuel & Manufacturing Company for itself and its successors or grantees hereby covenants to bury its lines of pipe so that the same will not interfere with the use of the premises as aforesaid.
