Now, on this 2nd day of April, 1921, the same being one of the regular days of the January, 1921, Term of the County Court within and for the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, the above entitled caused came on for hearing before the Honorable W. B. Williams, Judge of said Court, and it appears that the petition was filed herein by Charles Page on the 28th, day of December, 1920, and that statutory service has been obtained on all of the record claimants to the lands set up and described in said petition, to-wit:

Lot Two (2) or the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter,
of Section Seven (7), Township Nineteen (19), Range Twelve (12)
East, situated, in Tulsa County, Oklahoma,

and that due and legal service was obtained by publication on the unknown heirs of the said Emarthla, Deceased, and the court having heard the evidence finds that the said Emarthla was a full-blood Creek Indian of the Creek or Muskogee Tribe of Indians, and as such was duly enrolled opposite No. 6874, and that the above described land was allotted to him during his lifetime and that on the 6th, day of August, 1903, patent deeds were issued therefor.

The Court further finds that on or about the 2nd day of June, 1910, the said Emarthla departed this life intestate in and while a resident of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and at the time of his death he was survived by his wife, Mary Emarthla, nee Fuswa, now Mary Martin, and two children, Gabriel Emarthla and Kizzie Jefferson, nee Beef, as his sole and only heirs at law.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the said Mary Emarthla, nee Fuswa, now Mary Martin, and Gabriel Emarthla and Kizzie Jefferson, nee Beef, were the sole and only heirs at law of the said Emarthla at the time of the death of said Emarthla,
