

3. That the Grantee shall pay all damages to fence, crops and premises, which may be suffered by reason of laying, maintainance, operation or alteration of said lines of pipe. If not mutually agreed upon, said damages are to be ascertained and determined by three disinterested persons; one thereof to be appointed by the owner of the premises, one by the Grantee, and the third by the two so appointed as aforesaid, and the award of two of such persons shall be final conclusive.

This contract shall bind and run in favor of the respective parties hereto, their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns.

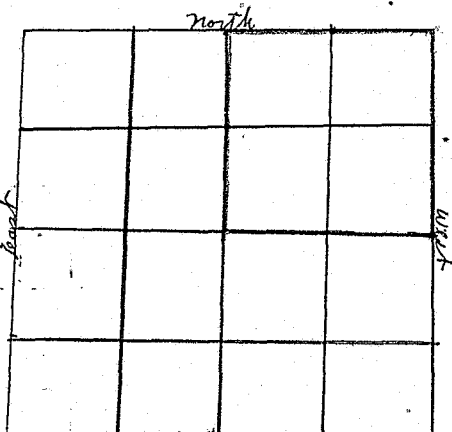
