

COMPARED

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF
COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF TULSA, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1: That the following described portion off
Detroit Avenue, between Fourteenth Street and fifteenth Street, in the City of Tulsa,
Oklahoma, to-wit:

The east five (5) feet of said Detroit Avenue and the
west five (5) feet of Detroit Avenue, all between the
south line of Fourteenth Street and the north line of
Fifteenth Street;

and also two certain portions of Eighteenth Street in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, to-wit:

One strip, seven (7) feet in width, lying immediately
adjacent to the present south line of Eighteenth Street:
and

One strip, seven (7) feet in width, lying immediately
adjacent to the present north line of Eighteenth Street;
and both measured at right angles from the said present
south and north lines, respectively, of said Eighteenth Street,
and lying between the west line of Carson Avenue and the
east line of the present right of way for parks and boule-
vard or Riverside Drive along by the Arkansas River;

and each and all of said portions and strips of land, be and the same are hereby vacat-
ed and abonded foreve as portions of said Detroit Avenue and said Eighteenth Street,
subject only to the provisions of the Charter of the said City of Tulsa,

SECTION 2: That all ordinances or parts of ordinance in conflict with the pro-
visions of this ordinance, in so far as such conflicts exist, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: That an emergency exists for the preservation of the public health
and safety, by reason whereof this ordinance shall take affect from and after its pas-
sage, approval and publication.
