One strip, seven (7) feet in width, lying immediately

adjacent to the present south line of Eighteenth Street:

and

One strip, seven (7) feet in width, lying immediately adjacent to the present north line of Eighteenth Street; and both measured at right angles from the said present south and north lines, respectively, of said Eighteenth Street, and lying between the west line of Carson Avenue and the east line of the present right of way for parks and boulevard or Riverside Drive along by the Arkansas River;

and each and all of said portions and strips of land, be and the same are hereby vacated and abonded foreve as portions of said Detroit Avenue and said Eighteenth Street, subject only to the provisions of the Charter of the said City of Tulsa,

SECTION 2: That all ordinances or parts of ordinance in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, in so far as such conflicts exist, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: That an emergency exists for the preservation of the public health and safety, by reason whereof this ordinance shall take affect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
