

## COMPARED

mentioned drafts or any extensions or renewals thereof at any time outstanding; except that in lieu of the following words contained in Exhibit A, to-wit:

"That it is the absolute owner of the oil hereinbefore described, free and clear of all liens and encumbrances whatsoever, except a lien to secure the said Nine Hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$950,000) of drafts maturing January 8, 1923, and any renewals thereof",

the following words shall be substituted, to-wit:

"The Oil Corporation hereby represents that it is the absolute owner of the Oil herein described free and clear of all liens and encumbrances whatsoever, except a lien to secure \$800,000 of drafts maturing April 9, 1923, and any renewals thereof."
