And it is further agreed, that if roreclosure proceedings be instituted, an Attorney's fee of ten per cent additional shall be allowed the aid fee in any case to be at least Twenty-five Dollars and taxed as costs in said case. But the Board of Directors of said Association may, at their option, pay or cause to be paid, the said taxes, charges, insurance, rates, liens and assessments so due and payable, and charge them agains t said Grantor or assigns, and the amount so paid shall be a lien on said mortgaged premises, and shall bear interest at the same rate specified herein, and may be included in any judgment rendered in any proceeding to foreclose this mortgage; but whether they elect to pay such taxes, insurance, charges, rates, liens and assessments or not, it is distinctly understood that in all cases of delinquencies as above enumerated, then in like manner the said note and the whole of said sum shall immediately become due and payable.
