View Addition to the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to  
the Recorded plat thereof.

 the true and lawful owner S of the said premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances; that there is no one in adverse possession of same and that

Richard Flood and Virginia Flood, his wife  
 will warrant and defend the same against the lawful and equitable claims of all persons whomsoever.

PROVIDED, ALWAYS, And these presents are upon the express conditions that, whereas, the said party of the second part at the special instance and request of the part ies the first part, loaned and advanced to

Richard Flood and Virginia Flood, his wife, the sum  
Fifteen Hundred and 00/100 DOLLARS,

AND WHEREAS, said part ies of the first part agree S with the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, to pay all taxes and assessments, general and special, against said lands and improvements thereon, when due, and to keep said improvements in good repair, and to keep the buildings thereon constantly insured in such company or companies as said second party may designate and the policy or policies of insurance constantly transferred to said party of the second part, its successors or assigns; and also to keep said lands and improvements thereon free from all statutory lien claims of every kind, and if any or either of said agreements be not performed as aforesaid then said party of the second part its successors or assigns, may pay such taxes and assessments, and may effect such insurance, for such purpose, paying the costs thereof, and may also pay the final judgment for any statutory lien claims, and may invest such sums as may be necessary to protect the title or possession of said premises, including all costs and for the repayment of all moneys so expended together with the charges thereon as provided by the By-Laws of said Association, these presents shall be security.

TULSA BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION their note or obligation, which is made a part hereof and in the words and figures as follows, to-wit:

For Value Received VS promise to pay to the order of TULSA BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, the following sums of money viz:  
 The sum of Nine and 97/100 DOLLARS,

the same being the monthly dues on the 15 share S of the capital stock of said Association, represented and evidenced by the  
 Certificate therefor numbered 4298 this day pledged by

Richard Flood and Virginia Flood, his wife, to said Association to secure a loan of  
Fifteen Hundred and 00/100 DOLLARS, and the sum of  
Eleven and 95/100 DOLLARS; the same being the interest

due monthly upon said sum so borrowed by ies and VS promise to pay said Association at its Home Office at Tulsa, Oklahoma,  
 the said sums of money, amounting in the aggregate to Twenty-one and 90/100 DOLLARS;  
 on the 15th day of each and every month, and continue such monthly payments for a term of 106 months from the date hereof  
September 15, 1923.
