ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS LEASE.

This agreement, made and entered into this 21st day of February, 1924, by and between Brooklyn Oil & Gas Company, a common law trust, by H. H. Breene, Charles West and L. E. Littell, the trustees thereof, hereinafter referred to as first party, and Black Sivalls and Bryson, Inc. hereinafter referred to as second party,

Witnesseth, that, whereas ^{on} the 17th day of April, 1913, a certain oil and gas mining lease was made and entered into by and between E. L. Donahoe and J. L. Donahoe, lessors and A. H. Black, J. A. Sivalls, W. G. Bryson and E. F. Black, lessees covering the following described land in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The north half (N $\frac{1}{2}$) of the northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$), less one acre in the northwest corner which is used for school purposes and the southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of section seventeen (17) township seventeen north (17N) range thirteen (13E) and containing one hundred nineteen acres more or less.

Said lease being recorded in the office of the County Clerk of said County, in Book 129, page 123,

And whereas, on the 9th day of March, 1921, John J. Donahoe, and Mrs. E. L. Donahoe made, executed and delivered to one Frank Sparks, a certain oil and gas lease covering the following described land in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

The northwest (NW) acre of the northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of section seventeen (17) township seventeen north, (17N) range thirteen east (13E) containing one acre more or less.

Said lease being recorded in the office of the County Clerk of said County, in book _____ page _____.

Whereas, the undersigned Brooklyn Oil and Gas Company claims to be the owner of an undivided interest in and to said oil and gas mining leases above described and in and to the tracts of land described therein.

Now, therefore, for and in consideration of the dollar (and other good and valuable considerations) the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said undersigned, Brooklyn Oil & Gas Company does hereby bargain, sell, transfer, assign, quit claim and convey unto Black, Sivalls & Bryson, all of its right, title and interest in and to said oil and gas mining leases above described and rights thereunder, together with all personal property used and obtained in connection therewith, and all of its right, title and interest in and to the said tracts of land hereinabove described, to said Black, Sivalls & Bryson, Inc. its successors and assigns,
